DIVERTER RAIN BARREL CARE Manage Water Where it Falls

INSTALLATION

Rain barrels capture rainwater from your roof to use later when it's dry outside to give thirsty gardens, flowers and trees a drink. Rain barrels help keep excess water out of the sewer system when it rains. They also help prevent rain from becoming polluted stormwater runoff-the biggest remaining threat to clean rivers and lakes in the United States.

INSTALLATION TIPS

- If your roof or gutters are in need of repair, do not install rain barrel until repairs are complete.
- Level the rain barrel by adding crushed gravel and compacting it down with a tamper or cinder block before adding the base.
- Measure your downspout before installing the FlexiFit Diverter:
 - If you have a 2×3 downspout you will drill the hole and insert the FlexiFit Diverter in the front of the downspout
 - If you have a 3×4 downspout you will drill the hole and insert the FlexiFit Diverter on the side of the downspout
- Make sure the FlexiFit Diverter piece that is in the downspout is installed below the top of the rain barrel rim (without lid on)
- Elevate barrel on cinder blocks for increased pressure

MAINTENANCE

SPRING	 Hook your rain barrel back up (directions in diverter kit) * Be sure rain barrel is level and diverter piece is below the top of the rain barrel Check the seals around the spigot and drain/hose attachment * Additional pieces can be ordered online at www.rainbarrelparts.com Make sure your downspout is directed away from your house (minimum of 4', preferred 10') Check your gutters for debris Use the water in the rain barrel within 3 days, if possible
SUMMER	 Use the water in the rain barrel within 3 days, if possible Regularly check 8 remove debris from your gutters and FlexiFit[™] Diverter
FALL	 Check your gutters for debris. If you typically have a lot of leaves/debris in your gutters, check & remove debris from your FlexiFit Diverter more often AT SEASON'S END (When temperature falls below 40°F): Remove leaves and empty the water out of the rain barrel Remove leaves from the rain barrel by removing the lid Spray the inside of the barrel with water and shake leaves out Remove the diverter piece from the downspout Secure winter cap over the hole in the downspout and screw into place Turn the rain barrel upside down and store in your garage or basement
WINTER	Let your rain barrel hibernate
