



Fresh Coast Guardians Rain Barrel Giveaway

1. Definition

"District" means the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District, the regional governmental agency that supports the [Fresh Coast Guardian initiative](#).

2. Eligibility

Any person over the age of 18 who lives in the [District's service area](#) may participate in the giveaway. Only one prize per household may be awarded.

3. How to Enter

Submit the form on the [Fresh Coast Guardians website](#) with an image or video of your rain garden or Wisconsin native plants in bloom.

4. Giveaway Submission Time Frame

The giveaway will start on July 10, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. CST and end on July 31, 2025, at 11:55 p.m. CST.

5. Selection of the Rain Barrel Winners

- (A) The District will select up to ten winners to receive an MMSD rain barrel. The selected submissions will be chosen that best show the use of water-absorbing rain gardens and Wisconsin native plants in bloom.
- (B) The District will announce the winner on the MMSD and Fresh Coast Guardians' social media pages (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter) on or before August 15, 2025.
- (C) The District's decision regarding winners is final, absolute, and binding.

6. Prize

- (A) [One RainStation, 50*gal EarthMinded*RS50 Rain Barrel](#)
 - 50-gallon capacity
 - Diverter system reduces overflows
 - Reversible "planter lid" is decorative and functional
 - 10-year UV resistance
- (B) The winner is responsible for picking up the rain barrel at the District (260 W Seeboth St – Milwaukee, WI 53204).

7. Cancellation

The District may cancel this contest at any time.



8. Ineligible Contestants

The following persons are not eligible for this contest: District employees or Commissioners, spouses of District employees or Commissioners, and dependents of District employees or Commissioners.

9. Use of Submitted Information

- (A) All submitted information becomes the property of the District.
- (B) By submitting information, participants authorize the District to use the information in the District's promotional materials, advertising, website, and marketing materials, without compensation to the participant.
- (C) Participants will hold the District and its employees and Commissioners harmless from any claims of any nature arising in connection with the District's use of information submitted for this contest.
- (D) The District may release participant information when necessary to comply with the law, enforce the District's website policies, respond to public records requests, or protect the District's or others' property or safety.

10. Telecommunications Risks

The District is not responsible for any problem, error, interruption, delay, virus, bug, loss of information, or theft of information caused by telecommunication networks, internet service providers, website hosts, software, or hardware.
